## Healthcare FSA

Per IRS regulations, pretax employee contributions to Health Flexible Savings Accounts (FSAs) contribution limit for 2024 is \$3,200, an increase of \$150 from the 2023 limits. Carryover of unused amounts, increased from \$610 to \$640.

## Dependent and/or Child Daycare Expenses

The 2024 cafeteria plan daycare contribution limit has been set at \$5,000 for a married couple filing a joint return, or for a single parent filing as "Head of Household." For a married couple filing separate returns, the limit is \$2,500 each.

## Health Savings Account (HSA)

For calendar year 2024, the annual limitation on deductions for an individual with self-only coverage under a high deductible health plan is \$4,150 and for an individual with family coverage it is \$8,300.

The "high deductible health plan" annual deductible cannot be less than \$1,600 for self-only coverage or \$3,200 for family coverage, and the annual out-of-pocket expenses cannot exceed \$8,050 for self-only coverage or \$16,100 for family coverage.

## **Commuter Accounts**

The monthly commuter benefit limits for both mass transit and parking increased by \$15 per month in 2024, for a maximum monthly contribution limit of \$315.

CAS documents allow for automatic IRS FSA limit increases, therefore there is no need for a document amendment. Please email the CAS team if you would like updated enrollment materials with the new IRS limit. If your plan has already re-enrolled or is re-enrolling now you can allow your employees to update their election to the new IRS limit due to this announcement.
